The news show content and production will be student-driven. Students will act as writers, journalists, reporters, camera people, lighting specialists and so on. Each student will be expected to take part in all aspects of production. One of the main goals is that each student gains experience editing digital video using current software.

Students will be able to

- video record to make viewable products
- use lighting to help enhance viewable product
- produce voice over
- determine the difference between copyrighted and copyright free music and use appropriately in their viewable product
- use different camera angles to achieve different effects
- import video into editing software, add transitions and audio to make viewable products
- Apply the steps in the writing process, including but not limited to
 - drafting
 - revising
 - editing
- write in a form appropriate for audience
- refine writing skills
- participate in oral presentations
- evaluate effectiveness of own work
- assess own strengths, weaknesses and need for improvement
