

# Summer Jump Program

The CKS Summer Jump Program features small group instruction to help prepare your child for the grade ahead. This is not a summer school or tutoring program, but a preparation course to help you and your child feel more at ease with the differences in the upcoming school year.

**Rising Pre-First Focus:** Practice decoding, and phonemic skills, strengthen comprehension, using writing and journaling to enhance fluency, addition and subtraction.

**Rising First Grade Focus:** Phonics: beginning, middle and ending sounds, vowel sounds, addition and subtraction, sentence skills, storytelling and story elements.

**Rising Second Grade Focus:** Math computation and concepts using interactive games and activities, reading fluency and comprehension in small groups, writing skills such as complete sentences and punctuation.

**Rising Third Grade Focus:** Introduce new texts, grading scale and literature, practice timed drills and math concepts, work on reading fluency and comprehension with Summer Reading texts. Writing Skills Including: headings, cursive, outlines, note taking and organizational skills.

Dates: July 7-10 and July 14-17, Monday-Thursday mornings 8:30-12:00

Location: Christ the King School

Cost: \$400 per child for the two week session.

Why: Your child is prepared for the first day of school. Back to school stress will be relieved. The program will keep kids actively thinking about school during the summer. Any concerns about the next grade will be addressed.
