(For Students Entering 7th Grade)

Students entering seventh grade are required to read the two books below and also complete the entire math Summer Math Skills Sharpener workbook and return it to school during the first week of school.

- A parent signature is required on the log form certifying that the student did read the two required books and the math workbook. The log form is available on the website.
- Students will have a quiz on the two required books listed below. This quiz will be given the first month of school. Quiz scores will be averaged in as part of each student's first quarter grade.
- The math workbook will be turned in to the math teacher and a quiz will be given over a sampling of the problems in this book.
- In June a reading guide will be posted on the Christ the King website that will help students remember key facts and themes in *Crispin* by Avi. Completing this guide is optional, but will help the student in discussions about the book in the fall. All students need to bring a copy of the book to school in August.
